

WE NEED AN ADDITIONAL BUILDING AT THE FARM... A MINI DORM FOR THE BOYS!





Thanks to a very generous donor's gift of \$20,000 we're close to being able to start construction of a mini dorm for the boys. The finished size will be 70 x 35 ft. and will hold 40 bunk beds to help sleep 80 boys.

Here is our plan ~ The building will be fabricated at the ICC (International Christian Centre) facility in Nairobi while the site is being prepared at the Farm in Kitale. The building will then be trucked to the site, and a construction team of local masons and artisans will arrive to erect the building!

We still need \$14,500.00 to be able to complete this project. (Total includes building materials/fabrication, labor, and bedding - mattresses, sheets, and blankets. Some of the boys' bedding is worn out!)

Musa was brought to Challenge Farm at age 7 with a critical life-threatening condition of 2 blocked heart valves. His relatives were unknown. At one point the doctors didn't think he would make it. In early 2016, Musa was taken to a hospital in Nairobi, Kenya's capital city, where he was all set to have heart surgery. The doctors saw such an improvement from his prior reports that they thought it was best to wait. The new heart medicine helped!

In 2017, his health declined. Now 3 heart valves were significantly damaged, and Musa's heart was unable to pump blood to meet his body's needs. He needed immediate surgery in Nairobi. Surgeons from Italy performed his open-

heart surgery pro-bono. Our donors rallied around this little guy and covered all his remaining hospital and medical expenses. Kreg Yingst, an artist in Pensacola, FL designed a special print to honor Musa and to help raise funds. The hospital bill was paid in full, the receipt read: "Baby Moses." God had sent baby Moses to us!

Musa (real name: Moses) hasn't stopped smiling since he came to Challenge Farm! He'll be 17 years old this year. God is so good! He started grade 9 in January and hopes to enroll in vocational training in January 2026. Musa goes to a cardiac clinic each month for checkups. He is doing well.
